Subject Tutoring Program

In the subject tutoring program, students receive in-depth tutoring in a specific subject. Your child will receive a diagnostic test to determine their unique strengths and needs. Using these results, we identify your child's academic goals and develop a strategic learning plan to help them develop and grow.

Working from a strategic learning plan means every session is targeted towards specific skills and topics where you child needs to improve. To complete a learning goal, students must demonstrate true concept mastery. This is different from many programs where students are said to have learned a topic if they've merely finished the workbook.

Classes are divided into 4 levels each representing a different ability level and key focus. Students take an entrance diagnostic to place them into the correct class for their current skill level. As students progress, they can test up at any point.

By focusing on foundational skills, students spend time mastering the most vital skills in each subject. This ensures that students can catch-up more quickly and understand what's being taught in their regular classes. For students who are already at grade-level, students can quickly advance well beyond their grade.

Daily Schedule

Our program is split into 4 tutoring sessions from 2:30-3:30, 3:30-4:30, 4:30-5:30, 5:30-6:30

Homework Assistance Schedule

Program Hours: 3:30-6:30

- Homework Assistance is offered from 3:30-4:30, 4:30-5:30, 5:30-6:30
- Students no longer have to pick specific days to attend, their enrollment gives them access to attend Mon-Thu. Students can attend any number of days each week during their chosen time-slot, giving families much more freedom and flexibility in schedules.

Subject Tutoring Schedule

Program Hours: 2:30-6:30

- Subject Tutoring is offered from 2:30-3:30, 3:30-4:30, 4:30-5:30, 5:30-6:30
- Parents may select any day/time combination that works for their schedule for private tutoring. For
 example, a student may reserve Mon from 4:30-5:30 and Thu from 5:30-6:30 as their permanent time
 slots.
